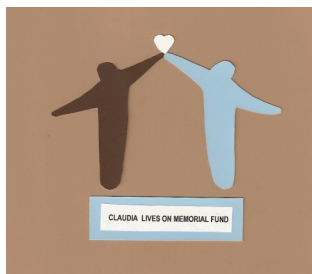


CLAUDIA LIVES ON MEMORIAL FUND

Claudia Lives On Memorial Fund Mission Statement:

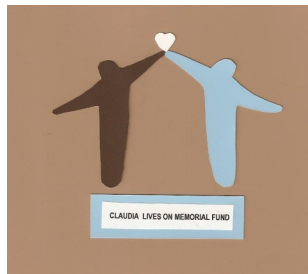

ABOUT CLAUDIA

Born with a passion for serving and empowering others, Claudia Thomas was directly involved with community ministries, sharing all levels of need from the basics of food, clothing and shelter to advancements in education and employment to inspirational guidance, both emotionally and spiritually. She was a team player who excelled at connecting service-seeking individuals with appropriate supportive resources. She was found in big things and little things— a dedicated volunteer who was a master at leading the helpers and helping the leaders.

In December of 2004, at the age of 53, Claudia Thomas' life was severely threatened. After stopping to assist with Good Samaritan efforts at a traffic accident, Claudia was struck by an automobile and suffered massive injuries which left her paralyzed. Throughout the magnanimous mountains this single mom climbed as she pursued ahead in her recovery journey, Claudia's rock-solid faith and deep devotion for serving others sustained and strengthened her. Chronic pain and fragile health conditions proved unable to weaken her stellar spirit. Her attitude of gratitude and passion for community service prevailed despite her escalating health limitations. She remained forever focused on helping others, especially women in need, as they journeyed forward with positive efforts toward healthy self-sufficiency. She did this simply by caring, unconditionally. Claudia passed on in 2006 and her memorial fund was established in 2007.
